If a club is cancelled due to lack of enrollment, we will let you know and refund your fee.
- Please include your **email address**, written clearly, on your registration form.
- **Fees are never pro-rated for any reason.**
- Please turn in your forms to the YHT office, and mark the envelope "After School Clubs – Danielle Ellman." Make checks payable to YHT-PTA.
- The committee cannot answer any transportation questions. Please direct any transportation questions to Yael Greenberger. Parents are responsible for picking up their children in the building **ON TIME**. All clubs end at **4:30 p.m.**
- **Friday Clubs** begin at **1:00 p.m.** and end at **1:45 p.m.** Parents are responsible for picking up their children in the building **ON TIME**. **Failure to pick up your child on time will result in your child being dropped from the Friday club. There is no late bus on Fridays.**

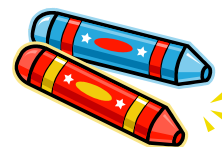

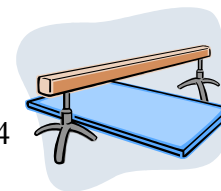

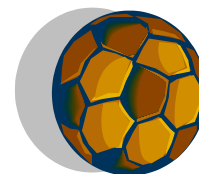
